- References should be written by individuals such as another member of the faculty or a workplace supervisor who know the nominee well enough to talk about the impact of their work first-hand.
- The letter should be current and written specifically for this award.

6. How does the nominee represent an emerging leader in policy? What are their future policy goals and aspirations?
7. What makes the nominee's efforts outstanding?
