LETTERS OF SUPPORT/REFERENCE

- Provide at least two (2) letters of support. (up to a maximum of five (5))
- Reference letters should be written by individuals who know the nominee well enough to talk about the impact of their work first-hand.
- The letter should be current and written specifically for this award.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

[Please address the following questions in your response. You may choose to include additional information to enhance the application, as is relevant.]

- 1. What problem were they solving?
- 2. How did the nominee take measurable action to solve this problem? Please provide a succinct timeline of the development process.
- 3. How many individuals were involved and what were their roles and contributions?
- 4. What challenges, issues or limitations did the nominee face in their work? What steps or action were taken to respond to these?
- 5. Provide specific examples of how the nominee is deserving of this award, based on the criteria (Link to Criteria)
- 6.In what ways is this an innovative policy/policy solution?

OUTCOMES AND IMPACT

- 1. What was the impact/outcome and how did they measure it?
- 2. What is the current status of the issue? What are the expected next steps?
